Step 1: Organize Your Records

- Separate business and personal accounts
- Gather all financial statements (bank, credit cards, loans)

Step 6: Use Tools & Systems

- Implement cloud-based accounting software (QuickBooks, Xero, FreshBooks)
- Set up dashboards for revenue, expenses, and KPIs
- Automate recurring reports (weekly, monthly)
- Ensure data is backed up and secure

Step 7: Seek Expert Support

- Schedule regular financial review meetings
- Get guidance on taxes, compliance, and growth strategy
